This is a contract position (1 year with the possibility to extend). The successful applicant will be responsible for:

- Developing The Federation's strategy related to BC's child and family serving system
- Working with Federation members, staff, and key contacts in government
- Identifying and utilizing strategic opportunities to influence change in the child and family serving system

We are seeking individuals who:

- Have deep and extensive knowledge about the child and family serving system in BC (including child welfare, children and youth with special needs, mental health)
- Are creative, hopeful thinkers who love strategizing, problem solving, and connecting the dots
- Believe in the power of relationships in social change work
- Can and will utilize anti-oppressive and de-colonizing frameworks to guide their work
- Are enthusiastic about forging new paths in uncharted terrain and are comfortable working with emergent processes towards a shared goal and vision
- Approach challenging work with compassion, kindness, and grace.

As part of our commitment to social justice and reconciliation, we encourage equity-seeking individuals to apply, including Two-Spirit people, non-binary folks, Indigiqueer, trans women, Indigenous women, Black women, immigrant and refugee women, and cis women.
