Good afternoon,

To support B.C.'s Restart Plan, the Province is working to buy and distribute Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and cleaning supplies to those delivering certain public services and serving vulnerable British Columbians.

The Provincial Supply Chain Coordination Unit initially focused its efforts on supply for the health sector. Now that there is a stabilized supply for front-line health care workers, the Province is making supplies available to eligible organizations listed at <http://www.gov.bc.ca/supplyhub>.

Products now (or soon) available for sale on the [COVID-19 Supply Hub](#) include masks, gloves, gowns, goggles, industrial cleaner, disinfectant cleaner, bleach and hand sanitizer. Additional products may become available.

Your organization is eligible to purchase the products required to operate safely, in accordance with Occupational Health and Safety regulations and guidance from the Office of the Provincial Health Officer. These products are intended to supplement, not replace, your current supply sources, as needed.

NOTE: This is separate and distinct from supply directed to the health sector. There is existing coverage for Medical-grade PPE required for health-related purposes.

To support employees within your organization who will be making the requests, we are holding two optional technical briefing sessions for users of the new ordering system. Those will take place:
